ABOUT TRAVERTINE

Used to influence architectural design since Ancient Rome, travertine is renowned for its delicate veining, soft natural tone and unique markings, making it a popular choice for high-end developments and homes around the world. Travertine is the core material of some of the world's most acclaimed landmarks, including the Roman Colosseum and Trevi Fountain.

Due to the nature of the stone, which is individually handcrafted by our expert stonemasons, travertine is completely unique to any other of its kind. Subject to each block, colour variations, shading and markings may differ, further adding to its appeal.

WHAT TO EXPECT WITH TRAVERTINE

WILL THE PRODUCT I RECEIVE BE IDENTICAL TO THE IMAGE SHOWN?

Travertine is a naturally formed material and due to this, no two pieces will ever be identical. Colours, shades, hues, patterning, surface deviations and veining are all natural characteristics which vary with every piece, so please consider this when looking at the representative images of travertine.

IF I ORDER TWO OF THE SAME ITEM, CAN I EXPECT THEM TO BE THE SAME?

As mentioned above, travertine is a natural product, therefore no piece will ever be the same. Please also consider that products can be cut from different blocks, which can result in shade and colour variations.

IF TRAVERTINE BREAKS OR CHIPS, CAN IT BE REPAIRED?

If large cracks are present in the main body of the travertine, we would advise fully replacing the travertine. There are independent specialists who can restore marks and damages back to its original appearance, however if the crack is large enough to effect the performance of the travertine, we advise full replacement.

DOES TRAVERTINE NEED TO BE SEALED?

Our travertine products are filled with clear resin to highlight its natural impurities and organic beauty. The products are then sealed, but they do require professional sealing at least once a year. If it isn't regularly sealed, your travertine product will be at risk of stains, damage, bacteria growth and mould.

HOW DO I CLEAN MY TRAVERTINE PRODUCTS?

Simple maintenance is required for travertine products. Including regularly cleaning with a damp cloth and drying with a soft cloth.
